The Regional Domestic Violence Firearms Enforcement Unit's mission is to reduce gun violence and increase victim and community safety through regional collaboration and proactive enforcement of firearms laws. This new regional Unit is the culmination of a multi-year system review, dedicated to developing effective strategies for Washington State's Protection Order firearm relinquishment law (RCW 9.41) and Extreme Risk Protection Order law (RCW 7.94).
