## Abortion Rights and Access



Consider donating or volunteering for abortion rights organizations. The Northwest Abortion Access Fund (NWAAF) is an abortion fund serving Washington, Oregon, Idaho, and Alaska. Trained, compassionate volunteer advocates run the toll-free hotline. NWAAF helps people pay for their abortion care by sending funding directly to the clinic. NWAAF also helps people get to and from the clinic and make sure people traveling for care have a safe place to stay.



Read the Abortion Care Networks 2022 Report on the new landscape of independent abortion clinics in the United States. In partnership with ineedana.com, Abortion Care Network collects data annually on every abortion clinic in the United States, each independent clinic is contacted annually for operational status and information on the scope of services provided.

Check out the Seattle Municipal Archives. The archives used sources within its holdings to compile resources exploring requests for police accountability in Seattle. Coming from the community, as well as from City committees and commissions, the requests resulted in evolving systems of oversight. By providing greater visibility to the historical record, they hope to create a window into how decisions surrounding police accountability were made in the past 65 years.
